What is the status of the homes located at 1814 and 1842 Powhatan? **1814 Powhatan Avenue has been to court and was dismissed on contingency of being sold, and the property was just sold last week. The new owner Mr. Jefferson Wells is not officially recorded yet through the Circuit Court Clerks office. 1842 Powhatan Avenue has also been to court and was dismissed due to compliance. The property is not eligible for spot blight per the City Attorney.**
